





A Special Unveiling and Dedication

During the 2023 event, there was a special unveiling and dedication that was somewhat secret in nature and was a whole lot of fun for those involved. Because of the importance of it, we want to be sure to share it with everyone who may not have known about it.

A few years back we started a program around the flagpole just North of the tower. The space is intended to be reserved to honor and recognize people who've made extraordinary and historical contributions to the show. There are pavers on the ground, some of which have been engraved with the names of some of these special performers, and there are a small number of benches to honor those of an even higher level. Naturally, the first bench was named in honor of the founder Chet Krause. The second and third benches were named in honor of the co-founder Cliff Mishler and longtime executive director Bob Crase. The fourth bench... well... we had a lot of fun with that one in 2023.

Joan Schultz began the show as a part time worker under first Executive Director Jim Bach back in 1985. From 1989-2000 she served as executive secretary under Bob Crase. From 2000-2019, Joan held the title of Executive Director.

Since her retirement in 2019, she has continued to support the show in a part-time role as Food Services Director, helping with the important job of ordering, coordinating and managing the food service and related supplies.

In her nearly 40 years of service to the show, she has seen almost every conceivable scenario, and interacted with virtually every participant and volunteer involved in the show. She has done this all at an amazingly high level, and with an unbelievable amount of humility. She's been involved in many of the show's greatest developments, and she's helped carry the show forward through thick and thin times. We have been really Blessed here at the show in so many ways by the incredible relationships we've developed. Many people have found themselves attracted to the things that happen here at Iola and want to be a part of it. It's a bit of a snowball effect that we're hoping to keep rolling.

A great example of that is our relationship with world-renowned photographer and artist John Hartman. John is one of the many people who fell in love with Larry and Rhonda Fechter's Vintage Mobil Station, and John has brought tremendous value to the show with his talents and connections ever since.

John Hartman was the visionary and photographer for this year's poster shoot, which was taken in downtown Stevens Point, WI. The backdrop provided an authentic classic downtown scene that feels perfect for this year's theme. The photo was taken on a very brisk early morning in late September, with cars and crew arriving at 5:30am to prepare for the shoot.

A wonderful cross-section of representatives from the Muscle Car Era were present. The car that formally launched the muscle car era, the 1964 Pontiac GTO, was brought in by owners Keith and Bonnie Weyers of Navarino, WI. The 1970 Plymouth Superbird was supplied by owners Rick Stoltz and Patti Kolesar Stoltz of Nekoosa, WI, and Allen Matison brought his 1969 Ford Mustang Boss 429 all the way from Earlville, IL.

During the shoot, John made the comment that the way the cars were positioned made it look as though they were talking to each other. He said, "It looks like a real meeting of the minds going on out there." Over my shoulder, I heard Patti say, "It's actually a meeting of the muscle." I knew that instant we wouldn't need any committee meetings to come up with the official wording for the 2024 theme. Patti had taken care of that for us with her off-thecuff comment, and it couldn't be any more appropriate for Iola '24!

While there are differing schools of thought and plenty of room for debate on what exactly fits the Muscle Car defi-



nition, we're generally talking about factory built mid-sized and smaller cars with High Performance V8 engines. The Muscle Car Era spanned from 1964 to 1973, ending largely because of government regulations and the oil crisis.

Each year, the Wisconsin Society of Automotive Historians (WSAH) are the primary voice when it comes to planning and staffing for the Special Exhibit. For the better part of an entire day, they reviewed a multitude of vehicles registered under the "theme" classification. During the selection process they hold the final say on which vehicles receive an invitation to be part of the indoor Special Exhibit. This year, you're likely to see great representatives of models such as; Pontiac GTO, Chevelle Super Sport/SS, Z28 Camaro, Plymouth Roadrunner, GTX, and AAR 'Cuda, Boss 302 and 429 Mustang, AMC Javelin/AMX 390/401, all Mopar Hemi and Wedge 426 and 340/440 Six Pack cars, Dodge Charger, Super Bee, and Challenger. Ford Fairlane GT and Thunderbolt. and others.



that transcends time perhaps better than any other era of auto design. Classic Muscle Cars are just as attractive to today's youth as they were so many decades ago. Make no mistake, that is not common to other periods of time. We've seen a resurgence over the last couple of decades of new models manufactured to evoke the looks and lines of their early predecessors. The growing popularity of touring/ restomod custom builds aim to pair modern performance and handling with the classic muscle styling. Much of what was designed during this period has held up well in the test of time.

To be sure, it will be difficult to top the theme of Iola '24.

They will be able to answer questions and have registration forms available on vehicle titles, registration, license plates for antique, collector and hobbyist vehicles. Golf Cart Path

Units with an official registration permit may be operated during normal show hours (6:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.) within the boundaries of the designated path only. Golf cart registration is located near gate #1. Privately owned golf carts will have a one-time \$50.00 permit fee, valid for the entire duration of the 2024 Show. If the cart is found in any other location, during these hours, its permit will be revoked at the discretion of Iola Staff or Security personnel.

Handicap Parking:

Enter the Spectator Parking through Gate #19 (Hwy J entrance) & proceed to the handicap parking lot located near Gate #1. Parking for the handicapped is located near gate #1. These vehicles must have an official handicap license. Handicapped persons riding in a vehicle without a handicap permit can be dropped off in the vicinity of the handicapped parking area and then the driver should proceed to one of the regular spectator parking lots.

Handicap Vehicles on Grounds:

The Iola Car Show allows mobility cart operation at any time on any part of the show grounds. A mobility cart is defined as a 3 or 4-wheeled electric, one passenger cart. Any individual may bring their own mobility cart to the grounds, or rental is available on the show grounds by Gate #1, near the handicap parking. Drivers of mobility carts are responsible for their operation. Wheel chairs, strollers and wagons are also available. For more details and to pre-register, call 262-677-2696, www.vistamobility.net. Absolutely no trailers or wagons attached to the mobility carts are allowed at any time.

IOLA CAR SHOW INFORMATION BASICS

Forms of Transportation:

The following forms of transportation are not allowed to operate on the show grounds: bicycles, scooters, skateboards, ATV's, lawn mowers, tractors, motorbikes, and golf carts without an official registration permit. (see the Golf Cart Path section for details)

Those who do not comply with this policy will be evicted from the grounds. If the offending party is registered on Iola Car Show space(s), the spaces(s) will be revoked without any refund of fees.

lce:

Ice may be obtained from the beverage area of the food stands and at the campground.

Information Board:

There is a board for posting messages located northeast of the commercial vendor building or across from the Thorson food stand. No advertising or posting of materials is permitted on any of the car show buildings, including but not limited to: restrooms, tower, registration facilities, ticket booths, or convention center building.

Lost & Found:

Lost & Found service is located at the Tower. Lost children should be brought to the Tower office. Missing children should also be reported there. We do not page individuals who become separated from their parties. When attending Iola it is suggested you work out a meeting area should your party become separated. A good place would be at the base of the Tower.

No Overnight Parking:

All parking areas should be cleared by 9:00 p.m. each evening. Officers will be checking to ensure the lots are cleared. No overnight parking of post-war vehicles is permitted, unless specific authorization is obtained from the Tower and the vehicles are moved to a designated area. Violation of these requirements may result in the vehicle being towed.

Parts Hauling:

This service is provided by Boy Scouts. Heavy-duty push-type garden carts are used, which can handle most parts, except heavy engines and bulky items.



Parts Pick Up Service: *Large or heavy items only

This is a parts pick up and hauling service for large or heavy items. Arrangements can be made to dispatch parts haulers to your location. There will be designated pickup points at gates where volunteers can transport parts and buyers back to the campgrounds, parking lots, etc.





No dogs or pets are allowed.

Service dogs are trained to do work or perform a task for persons with disabilities.

Comfort and/or emotional support animals are not service animals, and are not recognized by the ADA.

Pets:

No Pets allowed. ADA Compliant Dogs Only - must have paperwork. Service dogs are trained to do work or perform a task for person with disabilities. Comfort and/or emotional support animals are not service animals, & not recognized by the ADA.

Public Address Announcements:

Announcements emanate from the Tower. Personal announcements will only be made in cases of an emergency, such as a lost child, severe family emergencies, or severe health problems. We do not page individuals who become separated from their parties. It is recommended that you work out a meeting area should your party become separated.

Showers:

<u>Free showers</u> are available in the campground. Showers will be closed each night between 12 a.m. and 4 a.m.

Jola's (other) Secret Weapon THE STORY OF THE PIT CREW

Those who come to participate in the show as vendors, exhibitors and spectators should all be very familiar with the importance and power of the historic volunteer program. It's a drum we beat often, and it's truly a part of the magic that makes Iola what it is, and what separates us from so many other events. For this story though, I'd like to dive a little deeper into a much less celebrated, but no less important group. This is the story of the Pit Crew, told through the eyes of the local Executive Director, Joe Opperman.

When asked how long I've been involved in the show. I often say something like: Well, I'm 38 years old, so this is probably my 32nd or 33rd show. It sounds like a joke. but it isn't, and it's also not uncommon for people in this community. This event is a part of the lives of so many people who've grown up in this community. In my role now as Director, I can share a very unique perspective on some very key role-players. I grew up in the Iola-Scandinavia School District, and for as long as I can remember, Paul Ordway has been a present fixture from a distance in my life. Paul spent most of his career as an important member of the building and grounds/maintenance crew. As a child, I saw him nearly every school day working in the background on one thing or another. Paul is as skilled as he is quiet. If you know Paul, that says A LOT about his talent! He is one of the only people I know of whose brains and abilities to figure things out and fix things remind me of my dad's, and I cannot issue higher praise than that.

As I grew older in school, a couple other faces became a part of the maintenance crew that would later become a big part of my life. Around the year 2000, Larry Fechter was hired as the Director of Buildings and Grounds for the school district, and shortly after that he hired Earl Lederhaus to the team. Together with a few others, Larry, Paul and Earl were a heck of a team for the school district for more than a decade. Growing up around them, I never thought these people would have such a strong impact on my life, and the lives of



so many others we now serve together. Larry eventually retired from the school, and didn't stay retired long, as he took a job working for the car show in buildings and grounds. When the opportunity came to hire Earl here at the show, Larry jumped at it. I've heard a version of this story that includes Earl having about as much time as a morning coffee break between being employed for the school and the car show. With the addition of Earl, the ball Larry started pushing here at the show started picking up speed as they worked their way through improving facilities.

A few years back, Paul started thinking about retirement from the school district and soon after was hired as a part-time worker here at the show in his retirement. It wasn't long before part time became full-time. Just like that, the band was back together, and they were really making music!


At the risk of missing a few major contributors, I'm going to name a few additional core performers. Rick Stautz worked for a few years on the Pit Crew over the previous decade and brought his experience in city planning/engineering. Dennis Dickhut has been a regular part-time performer for several years and brings experience in electrical and HVAC that has been a huge asset to the show. Jim Payton and the A-Team have touched nearly every corner of the grounds and buildings improving things everywhere they go as unbelievable volunteers.

Most recently we've added Shawn Nollenberg and Bob Davis to the team. The talent and experience these two have brought is simply incredible. Shawn is a tradesman with lots of concrete/building experience and Bob's background in tooling/machining comes in handy all the time. It is simply amazing the level these two have helped take our crew to as a group.

We also have a regular contingent of seasonal help from high school kids who need a summer job. It's awesome to see these kids have the opportunity to work alongside of and learn from the wealth of knowledge and experience in the Pit Crew. They get lessons on work and life every day and are placed in an environment of camaraderie and teamwork I wish everyone could be a part of. My son is among this crew, and I can't tell you how much I appreciate that he has an opportunity to work with these guys. Come show time, they're answering the call servicing tens of thousands of guests, putting in long hours, and executing a world-class event. It is an awesome experience for them.

The volume and quality of work this extraordinary team does each year improving and preparing the showgrounds and facilities is a huge part of what makes the experience of Iola so great for so many people. They are a great group of guys with skills and attitudes that complement each other very well, and they're a lot of fun to work with. If you've been coming to the show for a long time, you've no doubt seen their impact over the last decade, and there are no signs of them stopping anytime soon. It's a tremendous honor to be able to call these guys teammates.

The Job is Uhat You Make It -THE HISTORY OF THE LITTLE FALLS LOGGERS GARBAGE CREW

Let's take it back to 1985, where directories were just \$1... Or were they? This was the year Little Falls Loggers made their volunteering debut at the Iola Car show. They were given an apron, a stack of directories to sell and some change. As they walked the grounds and up and down the aisles, selling these directories was getting harder and harder by the hour – no one seemed to want one. Margie and Dave, a husband-and-wife volunteer team, were determined and stopped at a group of swappers asking if they wanted to purchase one of the books for \$1. The group laughed and said they already got one for free up at the tent by the tower...

While the players have changed over the decades, the Little Falls Loggers (LFL) baseball group has been a constant force at the show. This baseball team started from humble beginnings... the Radies family settled in Little Falls, WI, and started a logging business almost a century ago. Farmers and loggers built the small town and from it, a baseball team in which most members were related in some way. The Radies started playing baseball with the slightly larger neighboring town, Big Falls, but eventually had enough players to start their own team and a rich history has grown since. Little Falls plays in the Badger Amateur Baseball Association (BABA), a competitive league that started all the way back in 1946!

To support the growing needs of the baseball team and field, the Loggers joined Iola in 1985. Thirty or so farmers and their supportive wives walked the car show and swap meet. The team also got their church involved, St. Peters, who still runs the car corral food stand to this day. They sold directories for two years, then their role migrated to the garbage duty.

In this role that they still fill today, they've been known by many names: Garbage Patrol, Sanitation Engineers, and most recently Environmental Specialists. With the help of families and fans, the Little Falls Loggers take on what is arguably one of the dirtiest jobs at the Iola Car Show with pride. Their work ethic, commitment to each other, and ability to find fun in hard jobs make them one of the most important groups at the Iola Car Show.

Watching this group work together is truly a pleasure, and they're an outstanding example of teamwork and leadership. Past, present and future players and fans work hand in hand with a smile on their face. The kids look forward to Iola every year because the adults have demonstrated how rewarding it is pitching in and working together. It is a beautiful thing.

For more than thirty years hordes of family and friends of the ball team have dutifully shown up before the show to



place garbage barrels and bags in preparation for the show. During the show, they work long hours on a constant rotation of emptying those barrels and moving them to unseen dumpsters for recycling and disposal.

When you walk around the grounds, take a moment to notice just how clean things are! There are more than 100,000 people here consuming food, beverages, buying and selling parts, and more. Nowhere will you find trash piled up or blowing in the wind, and that's because of the awesome job the Little Falls team does taking care of it. When you're here, you don't even think about it, and it's an awesome testament to a group that would be impossible to replace.

If you happen to see them working, please take a moment to tell them how much you appreciate their hard work. Better yet, if you're local, go catch a Sunday afternoon baseball game in Little Falls. We promise you won't be disappointed!

ONLINE REGISTRATION UPDATES

An enormous change to our office operations took place this year with the implementation of a completely new online registration system and process. In a lot of ways, this represents something I thought would be virtually impossible for us just a few short years ago. It didn't come easily, and it's by no means a perfect system, but the fact that thousands of participants were able to create their own account, login, and select their own swap, car corral and camping spaces this year isn't far from a miracle. Our participants being able to see the live view of the maps to self-serve and make choices about which spaces they want based on what's available, using current technology represents incredible progress for a small organization like us.

To share a little background on how this came about, we first started looking into suitable registration programs way back in 2016. At that time, and up until this year, we were heavily reliant on an excruciatingly manual process of paper registration forms, manual entry, and months and months of non-stop registration data entry and processing. Local tech genius Eric Danielson had created our own custom management system, pouring literally thousands of volunteer hours into creating and maintaining the system.

In addition to Eric's tech contributions, Joan, Mary and other office staff manually processed registrations, taking payments, making phone calls, negotiating adjustments and space changes. If you've never seen their desks during registration time, it's impossible to imagine the amount of work this is. Frankly, this place just wouldn't exist without their incredible work ethics, and like all technology, Eric's custom systems couldn't possibly last forever without serious overhauling.

Back in 2016, dreaming about swappers being able to view our maps in real time and select spaces for themselves truly felt impossible. Certainly, for larger companies this was a no-brainer, but not for us and our participants. Just a few years back, we came to the realization that this wasn't just a step we needed to take, it's one we couldn't afford not to take, and we began exploring options, meeting with companies and service providers that might be a fit and trying to determine the best option for our event.

Preparing for our 2024 online registration was something that started in earnest in the Fall of 2022, and a very custom build for our relatively complicated show began. Creating the maps, implementing our rules and deadlines, migrating historical data and all the other work involved was a huge effort that very often stressed our team and didn't go smoothly.

As of April 2024, I can say the system is working well for most parts of registration but is really a challenge for show cars in particular. We are working to improve this as best we can, and we have appreciated the patience of our exhibitors in the meantime.

There are definitely pros and cons with this new process. The biggest advantage to this new online system is our ability to communicate much more efficiently with our participants. Sending out emails with important updates to swap vendors, campers and show car participants is much faster and cheaper than the older and slower mailing system. Giving people control of their own spaces is another great accommodation the system provides. Something these systems will never be able to replace is the personal touch and diligence of the Joan's and Mary's of the world.

There are a few people I'd like to really give special recognition to in this big transition. Eric Danielson was crucial in helping us to evaluate our options and make selections about how to best approach this challenge. He was effectively working his way out of a job, though we know he's still very much needed in our operation.

Ali Johnson was truly the workhorse of helping to build the system, troubleshoot problems, migrate data and help see this through. The volume of work she took on in this long stretch of time in addition to her regular duties is huge, and larger than almost anyone is aware of. Without her, this simply wouldn't have happened. It's a big deal.

Mary Schwartz has certainly dealt with the greatest amount of stress in this transition. Making a change as drastic as this after doing things differently for decades is something most people simply couldn't do or would walk away from. In this case, Mary's been in charge of show car registration, which has absolutely been the most difficult part of the new system. As Mary does with everything, she overcomes, presses forward, and just keeps working.

Julie Seering is our team editor. She is thorough and has an objective view when it is needed most. On top of all her other responsibilities, Julie was able to back Ali up to review and verify accuracy of the data. Without her spreadsheets and drop-down fields, Ali would have drowned. Her support was greatly appreciated by all members on the team.

We will continue to work to improve this system and update the show in ways that make sense. We are planning for some changes in the campgrounds to transition some of the small sites into larger sites to help meet the demand of our campers. Similarly in the swap meet. we are hoping to invest in additional electric spaces and widening roads and pathways. Pricing will be updated where appropriate as well. We strongly encourage everyone who wants to renew their spaces for next year to do it during the show. This helps ensure you're way ahead of deadlines and makes the registration process smoother for everyone.

Thanks again to everyone who helped make this tough transition possible, and who worked through learning the new system and providing feedback. These sorts of updates help to ensure we're able to continue operating the Iola Car Show and Swap Meet successfully into the future.



Jola Car Show Grounds NEW ON THE GROUNDS SINCE IOLA '23



Iola '23 marked the third straight show of unbelievably nice weather and awesome crowds. Shows like that help us to continue on the mission of developing and maintaining the buildings and showgrounds in an effort to improve the Iola experience for everyone. We've made some great progress since last year that we hope is noticed and enjoyed.

Aiming to make the show more accessible and easier to enjoy, we're working on ways to help people travel the grounds to get where they're going a little bit easier. The mobility scooters, buses and cart path are all parts of that equation. In conjunction with those programs, we're working to widen some roadways to help decongest parts of the grounds. This isn't an easy task, and unfortunately, it's not a cheap one either.

Still, we've taken a great step forward with the widening of a major roadway running right through the center of the upper swap area. This improvement is also allowing us to add an internal bus route, that we hope will help to balance foot traffic and save people from walking through parts of the show they might not be interested in. As a new feature this year, we're sure there will be some bugs to work out, but we hope this will prove to be a great way to help people move about the grounds.

You'll notice we stumbled onto a pair

of "really sweet" older bus stop shelters, which at one time served the city of Madison, WI near the State Capitol. These beauties look right at home positioned near Gate 1 and just North of the tower on our grounds.

Another addition that will be hard to miss is an enormous set of bleachers in front of the main stage. Like the bus stops, these bleachers were purchased thanks to some savvy shopping on Facebook Marketplace and some online auction sites. The bleachers came out of the school district of New Glarus in Southern Wisconsin. It'll be a great spot to watch vehicle unveilings, musical entertainment, and everyone's favorite pinup contest -the annual Miss Iola Pinup Contest!

There are a couple of important acknowledgements associated with the bleacher acquisition. Local high school coach and elementary school teacher Connor Drath volunteered to join Pit Crew member Hayden Nelson and Joe Opperman for a very early morning to start the deconstruction. Leaving around 4 am on a brisk fall day, the crew got started in New Glarus as soon as the sun came up. The goal was to get about half of the job done in order to save the rest of the pit crew from needing to do an overnight trip. Thanks to the hard work of Connor and Hayden, that's exactly what happened, and this

large project was fully completed and hauled back to Iola in just two singleday efforts.

Making matters even better, we later received some funding to help cover the costs of this improvement from the Waupaca Area Convention and Visitor Bureau. This same organization has made a big impact here since 2020, having issued grants in support of the initial stage construction project, the development of the cart path, and now towards the bleachers. We are so appreciative of their ongoing support in helping to make Iola a better experience for everyone.

Things we are hoping to address in the near future include continuing to pave wider paths in the swap meet, add electrical/internet spaces, and perhaps build a dedicated shower facility to serve our swap vendors. Investments like this aren't possible without successful shows, and we appreciate the part you play in making this show a success.

It's a way of paying it forward, and that's what our Cruise of Honor program for our local veterans is all about. I was honored when Iola Car Show Senior Adviser, Larry Fechter, thought of me to help revitalize this awesome program to what it is this year... and it is our hope that this program continues to evolve to even greater heights in the future.

It's part of my joy, duty, and honor to help lead the charge to make our Cruise of Honor program an awesome experience for our local veterans from the King Veterans Home. Our veterans will be brought here by special vehicle on Thursday and Friday before 10 a.m. The veterans will be part of a cruise that will start by the Vintage Mobil Station near Gate #4 and go around the Iola Car Show building. When you see a veteran on the grounds this weekend. please thank them for their service. It cannot be said enough. And now, here's a bit more about me...

I was born in Waupaca on March 19th, 1982 and raised in Iola by my grandmother and uncle following the passing of my mother at age 19 when I was only six months old. My connection with the veterans in the Iola-Scandinavia/Central Wisconsin community began as a child by going with my grandmother to the monthly American Legion-Post 14/Auxiliary meetings. I was fortunate enough to be part of Badger Boys State in



1999, an annual event with direct ties to veterans and members of the American Legion.

If you were in Iola for the annual Memorial Day parade, you could find me helping my grandmother give out poppies and flags on Main Street. You could also find me helping out at the Iola Military Show when it was still in Iola. I didn't realize or think about it at the time, but it was the time I spent going with my grandmother to all those legion/auxiliary meetings, helping her at the Memorial Day parades, and helping out at the Military Show where my connection, honor, and admiration for what my grandmother did for this community and for what our veterans do began.

I was able to spend a lot of time with the veterans in this community who were members of the American Legion-Post 14. I would always get a kick out of them coming to school for Veterans Day as they would always have a ceremony at the school to honor our veterans past and present. I would see them and think: "I know these people...it's so cool!" In my mind I thought it was some kind of advantage I had over the other kids... and maybe it was because of the time I spent with them hearing their stories and gaining their wisdom. It was also interesting seeing my grandmother there representing the auxiliary with the rest of the ladies. I always felt like she was watching me carefully when she saw me in the auditorium as to make sure I behaved myself.

My fascination with classic cars started when I was nine years old at the Iola Car Show in 1991. That was the first year I helped my grandmother at Gate #3, where we volunteered our time at the Iola Car Show for the next 12 years together. My dream to have a classic car of my own started at the 1995 Iola Car Show. With patience and perseverance, my dream finally came true when I bought a 1973 Corvette Stingray at the car corral on day one of the 2021 Iola Car Show.

You can find my Stingray, named "Karen" after my mom, in the survivor area of the grounds each year.

After graduating from Iola-Scandinavia High School in 2000, I went to UW-Stevens Point and graduated in 2004 with a degree in Communication-Media Tech.



Following college graduation, I began my broadcasting career as a part-time radio announcer for what is now Lakes 92.7, WDUX in Waupaca on Christmas night in 2004. I got my first full-time job as an antiques and collectibles book editor for Krause Publications/F & W Media in Iola, where I worked from 2005-2010.

I transitioned from part-time announcer to fulltime announcer in 2012 before leaving WDUX in 2020, but not before winning five awards from the Wisconsin Broadcasters Association. 

"It is a true testament to their community mindedness," Ali states. "Some of the photographers are giving up thousands of dollars they could be earning this weekend to instead volunteer and donate their time to an organization of their choice. Some are just starting out and are using it as a base to build off of. It's incredible to see the variety these photographers bring to the table!" As all of Iola is built on people willing to give their time and talents for three days, so to do these photographers. So if you see them with their yellow media badge, offer thanks, share your story, and grab a business card - these are the kind of photographers you'll want capturing your family photos, senior pictures or professional car shots.







In the fall of 2022, we approached Village of Iola Board President Jennifer Schustek with an idea we were really passionate about. We, the staff at the Iola Car Show, are always talking about the recognition our community garners as a result of the national notoriety generated from the annual Iola Car Show. We want to encourage elements within the village to embrace that attention and find ways to bring more people and business to town with similar theming, showing cohesiveness as a community. We worked with Eric Danielson, a close friend of the show who does photography as a hobby. He helped us to position the car and camera for the shoot and something very cool happened in the process. Eric's son, Emmett, was assisting him throughout the day of the shoot. Without Eric knowing, Emmett had collected a few images of his own on one of Eric's back-up cameras. 



Under the supervision of trained foundry men and women, attendees don safety equipment, manufacture the sand molds, help pour liquid tin into molds, and use files to sand off rough edges to make a variety of objects including keys, paper weights and horseshoes. Waupaca Foundry in a Box is as the name suggests: a traveling foundry in a metal box along with a small electric furnace that melts tin to about 500-degrees. Molds to hold the liquid tin metal are made from a mixture of sand and vegetable oil. The process is very similar to building a sand castle where sand is packed to create impressions in the mold. During the demonstration, Waupaca Foundry employees explain that engineers, machinists, metallurgists, operators, and others created Waupaca Foundry in a Box and educate students on how the tasks they are doing relate to jobs in the foundry.

Billed as a secondary character in the first season, Winkler became an overnight success with his "coolness" and catchphrases. Don Most is well known as the jokester, Ralph, in the series. His focus was on girls and humor,

Stan has been directing and producing since his tenure as Chip and boasts an impressive 65 years in the entertainment industry.

JON PROVOST

Lassie is the eighth longest-running scripted U.S. primetime television series and captured the hearts of America from 1954 to 1973. This sitcom was first aired in black and white and transitioned to color in 1965. Jon won the role of Timmy in 1957, joining the show at the top of its fourth season. For the next seven years, he and Lassie were inseparable. Jon played the role with three separate dogs, all descendants of the original Lassie, Pal. He also published his memoir, Timmy's in the Well: The Jon Provost Story, in December 2007.



Two of the strongest names in the industry will be featured in Iola's new "Art Walk" space located inside the Convention Center near the Merch Store.



A Legacy of Community Giving

In 1972, Chet sent out a simple letter inviting a few friends to an afternoon hosted by the Iola Lions. About 20 cars gathered on the grass near Lake Iola to chat about the Old Cars Weekly publication that was started just the year before. Just like that, the event was launched and in a matter of just a couple of years had grown so much in size and popularity it outgrew the park.

In 1976, the event migrated to its current location, surrounding the growing Krause Publications operation, where it was becoming the premier swap meet in the Midwest. It relied heavily on support from local organizations to manage parking, food services, garbage and other event hosting needs, and in 1984 was incorporated as Iola Old Car Show, Inc., a 501(c) (3) Charitable Non-Profit Corporation.

At the time of transition to 501(c)(3) in the mid-1980s, efforts were being led by 4 community organizations, which included Iola Lions Club, Iola Fire Department, Iola Winter Sports Club and Iola-Scandinavia Jaycees. All of

which have an interest in serving our community through their charitable efforts. As the crowds kept growing, naturally more help was needed, and the Community Organizations grew to 13, adding Iola American Legion, Iola Conservation Club, Iola Hospital Auxiliary, Norseman Snowmobile Club, Ogdensburg Fire Department, Sons of Norway, Stevens Point Old Car Club and the Waupaca VFW. Over time, more than 100 additional community organizations have been added to the ranks to assist in making our flagship event possible. We are all working together to positively impact our community.

Those organizations gather volunteers to help operate the various jobs during the event, and the organizations receive proceeds from the event. To date, Iola Old Car Show, Inc has issued more than \$9 million to those volunteer organizations and community projects.

Along with charitable giving, the Iola Car Show has an incredible eco-


nomic impact for central Wisconsin. That isn't something we take lightly. Together with key volunteers, our small staff of office and grounds personnel work year-round planning, developing, and maintaining the annual event and related support infrastructure.

A recent economic impact study concluded the annual event is responsible for as much as \$25-\$30 million for Waupaca County and the six connected counties. This is the equivalent of approximately 250 full-time jobs right here in the center of Wisconsin.

Because of the notoriety and natural association between "Iola" the national known event, and "Iola" the community, it is our mission to continue to develop and maintain the annual event and our surrounding communities to ensure sustained viability now and into the future. We are a community resource for support through funding, concept development and so much more.















Show Car CLASSIFICATIONS

Have a show car and want to show it at lola?

We hope the following descriptions will help you to display your vehicle in the area where it will be seen and appreciated most! Please note the following:

Some classes have differing requirements for years of production accepted.

Pre-registration, Pre-Approval, and picture submissions are required for some classifications.

Iola is not a competition! Each vehicle receives a dash plaque, there are no trophies or awards. Just relax and enjoy yourself! Each registered vehicle receives two wristbands – admission for participant and one guest.

"For Sale" signs are not permitted to be displayed on or in a vehicle.

Theme Display:

Each year the Iola Car Show is proud to recognize a theme. Although some cars will be asked to park inside the Special Exhibit building, that is usually arranged in advance by the show car director and the WSAH (Wisconsin Society Auto Historians). Theme area also has special parking south of the Iola Car Show Convention Center on the pavement.

2024 Theme - MEETING OF THE MUSCLE

There has long been debate on what defines a "Muscle Car." The term was originally applied in the mid-1960s to intermediate size two-door, rear wheel drive American passenger cars with a factory high performance, often big block, V8 engine, from model years 1964-1972. For the Iola '24 Special Exhibit display, we will stay with the original definition and include factory high performance "Pony Cars," such as Mustang and Camaro, which fit the definition soon after their introduction. Examples of models we would like to have displayed are: Pontiac GTO, Chevelle Super Sport/SS, Z28 Camaro, Plymouth Roadrunner, GTX, and AAR 'Cuda, Boss 302 and 429 Mustang, AMC Javelin/AMX 390/401, all Mopar Hemi and Wedge 426 and 340/440 Six Pack cars, Dodge Charger, Super Bee, and Challenger, Ford Fairlane GT and Thunderbolt, to name just a few. Pre-registration is required. There is no fee.

Blue Ribbon Concours:

Showcases 1990 and older vehicles that are high quality restorations or fine origi-

nal examples. Factory paint colors, stripes and decals, interior colors/materials, drivetrain, wheels, and model options are highlighted. This exhibit displays vehicles as if they were originally manufactured and provides correct examples for historical and restoration purposes. The show car director may issue an invitation, but we also accept applications for this area to be reviewed by the committee. Photographs are required for approval. Approved vehicles will be added to the Blue-Ribbon Concours invitation list for each year, and they cannot modify vehicle. Pre-registration is required. There is no fee.

Pre-War Display:

Open to all vehicles produced up to 1942 with few to no modifications. There is no fee.

Post-War Display:

Open to all presentable vehicles produced from 1945-1995. Fee is \$15 for duration of event.

Modified Display:

Welcoming vehicles 1995 and older that are considered hot rods, street rods, customized, low riders, rat rods, kit cars, tributes, and replicas. Fee is \$15 for duration of event.

Old Cars/Young Drivers Display:

We celebrate our hobbyists under the age of twenty-five who own and/or have built a classic vehicle. Cars are encouraged to be at least 25 years old, but exceptions may be made if approved. These vehicles do not have to be show-quality but should be visually presentable and in running/driving condition. Stock and modified vehicles of all manufacturers are welcome. Date-of-birth is required for approval. Once approved, you may display in this area until you age out. Pre-registration is required. There is no fee.

Survivor Display:

1976 or earlier production vehicles that are presented as they came from the factory, wearing original paint, interior options, upholstery, chrome, wheels/hubcaps, and original power/drive train with no mechanical modifications. A survivor has been driven and may show signs of wear but is in particularly good, presentable condition and has obviously survived due to great care taken by owner(s), maintenance, and proper storage. It is a time capsule that has been maintained, but retains 80% or more of what it left from the factory with (not including regular maintenance items, such as belts, hoses, tires, exhaust, etc.) Photographs are required for approval. Once approved, vehicles are allowed to be displayed in this area as long as there have been no changes made. Pre-registration is required. There is no fee.

Late Model Vehicle:

Celebrates 1996 and newer unique and prestigious late model productions. Photographs are required for approval. Vehicles are approved at the discretion of Iola Car Show staff and must be pre-approved each year. Fee is \$15 for duration of event.

Women With Wheels:

This display highlights and celebrates women in the car hobby. Our goal is to empower others to pursue and participate in the hobby as well as demonstrate that gender is not a determining factor in classic vehicle interest, ownership, or knowledge. Pre-registration is required. Fee is \$15 for duration of event.

Original Owners:

This is a new category dedicated to celebrating vehicles that have been owned by the same person, or within the same family, since being purchased new in 1976 and earlier. To qualify we will need you to verify with a copy of your Vehicle Title. Once we confirm it to meet the "Original Owner" category, we will include a window cling badge that you're welcome to retain with the vehicle at your discretion. What is the CodeRed Emergency Alert System and why is this system important to me?

Waupaca County utilizes what is known as the CodeRed Emergency Alert System when a critical incident or emergency situation takes place within the county. We use this system to notify the entire county or specific areas within the county of important information. This system is a database of resident and citizen information for use only in critical and emergency situations. The CodeRed System is used to send critical communications from evacuation notices, to hazardous weather alerts, to missing children alerts. When residents and citizens enter their information into the CodeRed Emergency Alert System, they are added to a nationwide database set exclusively for emergency community alerts in emer-


